Camel animals and fiber treatment

As per statements received from our raw material suppliers, we can state the following:

Camels are living in pastures, where they can walk freely and do not have much contact with humans. Farmers only need to set several water points for them and do not need to prepare any additional food for the animals. The animals seek food themselves in pastures, which are not fenced.

People raise them mainly for meat. Fibers are not the main or only purpose. Some animals are also raised for milk production. In the past, when transportation was very inconvenient, they were good means of conveyance for local people.

During the time of season changes, people gather the animals at the water points to do the clipping with scissors or collect the fiber from the ground, as it just falls off. We hear that in Alashan area, there are also some people who use brushes to collect the fine camel hair.

After clipping, people sort out fibers of different body parts. The longest and coarsest parts are the raw material for wigs.

The scouring mill is using water from the local distributor; the waste water is further processed in the waste-water processing mill established by the local government. The scouring mill uses APEO free detergent only. Of course, there is no children working in the mill, which is illegal.

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Cashmere animals and fiber treatment

As per statements received from our raw material suppliers, we can state the following:

Cashmere goats are living in pastures, where they can walk freely and do not have much contact with humans. Farmers only need to set several water points for them. In Mongolia, the animals seek food themselves in the pastures and are usually not fed with food supplements; in China, the animals are being fed, as letting them eat free on the farms is forbidden due to desertification.

People raise them mainly for meat. Fibers are not the main or only purpose. Some animals are also raised for milk production.

During the time of season changes, people gather the animals at the water points to do the combing or clipping with scissors.

After gathering the fiber, farmers are sorting the Cashmere on color.

The scouring mill is using water from the local distributor; the waste water is further processed in the waste-water processing mill established by the local government. The scouring mill uses APEO free detergent only. Of course, there are no children working in the mill, which is illegal.

All Cashmere qualities we are supplying are coming from animals which are not under CITES declaration.
